



About Safety Town

Safety Town is a two-week educational summer program for children sponsored by the Barrington Junior Women's Club. Safety Town participants learn important safety lessons through hands-on activities and demonstrations. The Safety Town permanent site, located at The Orchard Evangelical Free Church (formerly Health World), was built in 1997 through community support and is an integral part of the program. This miniature town gives the children hands-on experience in using safety skills while riding bikes and acting as pedestrians. Speakers, movies, songs, poems and art projects that support safety lessons are completed in a classroom setting. A field trip to the Barrington Police and Fire Department are also included in this program. The Safety Town program is designed to help children enjoy and understand safety rules and lessons.

Four (4) Safety Town sessions are offered for 2010:

Sessions 1&2 are offered June 14-25. Sessions 3&4 are offered July 12-23. **During the two-week sessions, children attend classes Monday through Friday for two and a half hours each day at The Orchard Church in Barrington (formerly Health World).**

The Safety Town enrollment fee is **\$100**. Scholarships are available based on financial need. To request a scholarship please contact BJWC by April 30.

Enrollment Information

Children who will be five years old by 9-01-10, entering kindergarten or first grade, residing in zip code 60010 or enrolled in a CUSD 220 school, and who have never participated in Safety Town before, are eligible to register during our walk-in registration on Saturday, April 10th. Following walk-in registration, in district and out of district campers may register by mail-in or on the internet, www.bjwc.org.

Walk-in Registration: Walk-in- registration will be held at the Barrington Police Station on Saturday, April 10th from 8:30 a.m. until 11:00 a.m. This in-person registration enables immediate confirmation of session assignment and affords better selection of sessions, since many of the morning sessions and some afternoon sessions fill up quickly. Each person registering will be able to register a friend at the same time. This alleviates registration congestion and enables your children to be enrolled in the same session (helpful for carpooling!). **Please be sure to bring along a completed, signed application form and enrollment fee for your friend; otherwise we won't be able to register them!**

Mail-in or Internet Registration: All mail-in registrations and internet registrations are processed on a first-come/first served basis after the walk-in registration. For mail-in registration, fully complete and sign the attached application and include a check for \$100 payable to BJWC. Please mail to: BJWC Safety Town, 26301 W. Roberts Lane, Barrington IL 60010. Please include a self-addressed, stamped envelope so that we may send you a confirmation. For internet registration, access www.bjwc.org and select the Safety Town link. You may complete your form and payment on-line. Please note there is a surcharge when registering on-line. Mail-in registrations and internet registrations should be received prior to Friday, May 29th.

Cancellation Policy: If your child is unable to attend the Safety Town session that you are confirmed in, you must inform us at least two weeks prior to the start of his/her session in order to receive a tuition refund. After that date, refunds will be subject to our ability to fill the spot you vacate.
